## Renewable Energy Certificate Assignment Form For Solar Photovoltaic System

### OWNERS INFORMATION FOR ASSIGNING REC'S

Owners of eligible solar (photovoltaic) systems may qualify under the Renewable Energy (Electricity) Act 2000 (the Act), to create and trade RECs. RECs exist electronically in the internet-based REC Registry ([www.rec-registry.gov.au](http://www.rec-registry.gov.au)) and represent the equivalent of one megawatt hour (MWh) of electricity generated from an accredited renewable energy source.

There are a number of eligibility requirements a solar (photovoltaic) system must meet in order to create RECs, which may vary depending on the installation date of the system. You may assign RECs in 5 year periods or in a one off 15 year period. To be eligible for the 15 year deeming period the unit must be designed and installed by a person accredited for stand-alone and grid-connected power systems under the BCSE accreditation scheme or the Clean Energy Council accreditation scheme.

**Owners of solar (photovoltaic) systems that qualify as small generation units under the legislation have two options to benefit from RECs:**

1. Register with the ORER, apply for an account in the internet-based REC Registry system, create RECs in the REC Registry, negotiate the sale of RECs and transfer RECs to the buyer; or
2. Assign their right to create RECs to a registered Agent. In return, the Agent may provide a discount on the purchase price of the equipment, offer a one-off payment for the RECs, or agree to some other financial arrangement. In this situation the Agent owns the RECs and is responsible for creating and trading them.

The financial value of a REC is dependent on the supply and demand of RECs, and may vary between buyers from day to day. Under Section 24 of the Act, any instance of improper creation of RECs may result in referral for prosecution regardless of the reason for the improper creation. Providing false or misleading information under Part 11A of the Act is a criminal offence.
